Installation

IMPORTANT: You must be on Microsoft Dynamics GP October 2021 (18.4.1361) release or U.S. Year-End Tax Update 2021 (18.4.1384) release before installing Signature Equipment Management 18.04b06. Verify version information by checking the About Microsoft Dynamics GP window. If you are not on this version, do not install Signature Equipment Management.

These installation notes only apply to users who are upgrading from a previous Equipment Management version. New Equipment Management users should refer to the *Equipment Management Installation, Upgrade, and New Features* user guide for installation instructions.

You can upgrade to Signature Equipment Management 18.04b06 from Equipment Management 2016 R3 Service Pack 1 (16.00b03g306) or higher.

Installation Notes

- Modified Equipment Management and Microsoft Dynamics GP windows and reports may be lost after upgrading. Print copies of all modified windows and reports to use as a reference, as you may have to recreate your customizations after installation.
- This upgrade is installed using the Equipment Management installation wizard. All users must log out of the system before upgrading. To start the installation wizard, download and launch the application file on the server machine. For complete installation instructions, refer to the *Equipment Management Installation, Upgrade, and New Features* guide.

 To install Equipment Management sample data, you must be logged in to the Fabrikam lesson company. If you are logged in to a different company, you will receive an error when trying to install sample data.

- **Advanced Rental users** - Line linking has been updated so that linked (child) lines are updated by the parent line. The child line can also be updated independently without updating the parent. 22026

- **Advanced Rental users** - You can update the intervals for and the automatic On/Off Rental processing. In the Dex.ini settings, update the following line to the appropriate number of minutes between processing. The default setting is to run the process every 5 minutes. Setting the number to 0 will set the process to not run.

- **Vehicle Readings users** - You can update the intervals for and the automatic Commit Vehicle Readings processing. In the Dex.ini settings, update the following line to the appropriate number of minutes between processing. The default setting is to run the process every 5 minutes. Setting the number to 0 will set the process to not run. 21573

Issues Fixed

Case #	Description
EMS-10	When re-using a rental invoice batch name and then printing using the SRS Batch Print option now prints invoices as expected.
EMS-50	We've fixed an issue where the error messages displayed were associated incorrectly with the action. When importing Equipment Management equipment and a life UOM does not exist, the error message "Equipment Unit of Measure is invalid" now displays. When importing equipment with the status not existing, the error message "Equipment Status is invalid." displays.
EMS-54	On the Equipment Manager, Location Log tab, the sort order by date is now displaying as expected.
EMS-65	We've updated an error message that displays when attempting to update a rental agreement line for equipment that was previously deleted. The error message now says "Error processing the On Rental or Off Rental request. Verify the equipment on the agreement line still exists."
EMS-67	Users will no longer receive the error "The rental line is not fully invoiced." when marking the Complete button in the Rental Agreement with the Disable Invoicing marked. The application will only check if the line is fully invoiced if the agreement and the line are not marked to disable invoicing.
EMS-76	Users who do not have the Advanced Rental module registered are now able to complete the Documents Attachment Setup window.
EMS-81	Rental invoices now print as expected when the invoice is negative.
