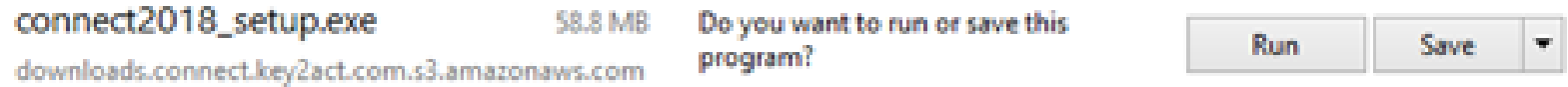

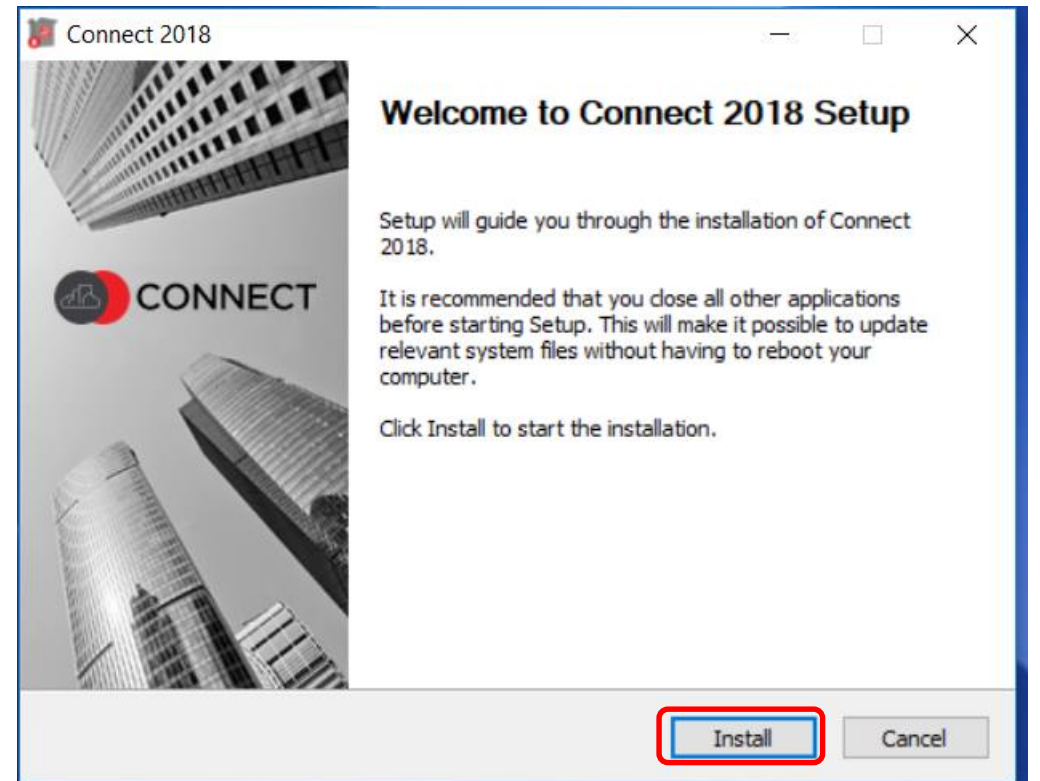
Installing and Licensing the Connect2018 UI

To install the Connect UI, go to the following link - [Connect 2018 Setup](#).

A message displays asking, "What do you want to do with connect2018_setup.exe?" You can save the file to your computer and then double-click to run the file or choose Run to start the installation.



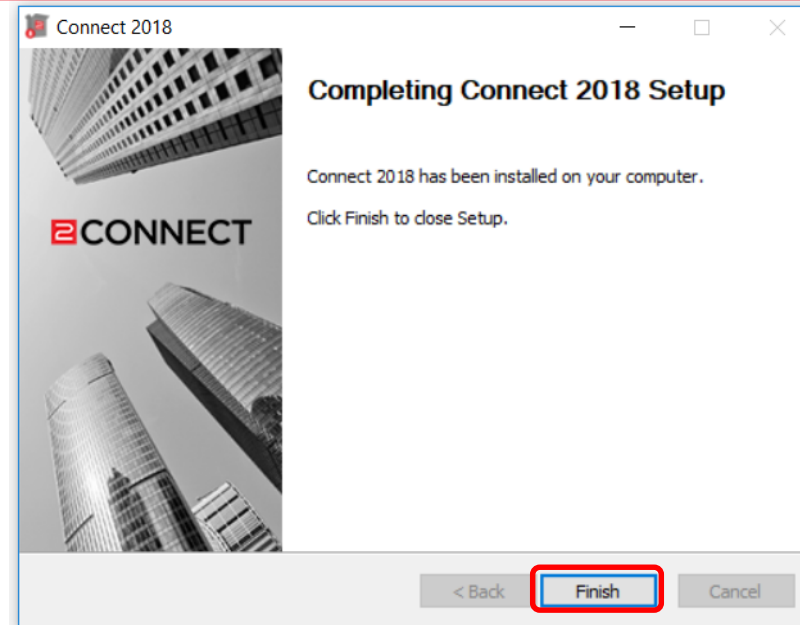
In the Welcome window, choose *Install*.



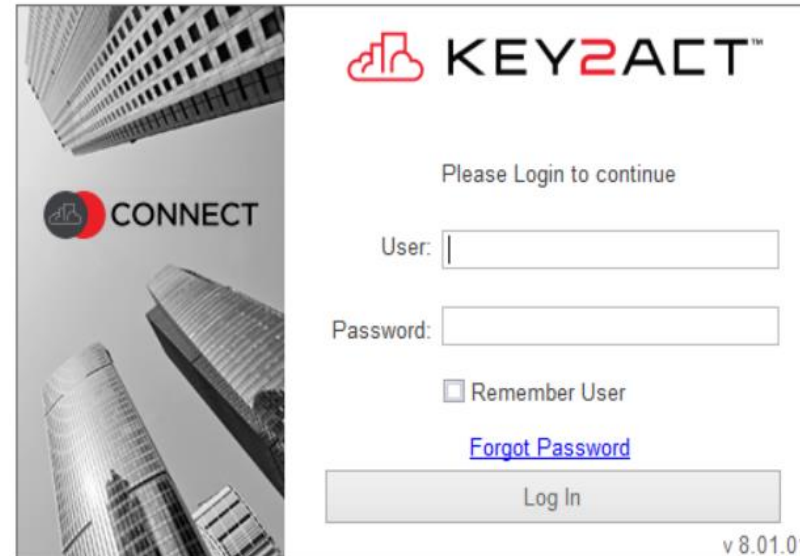

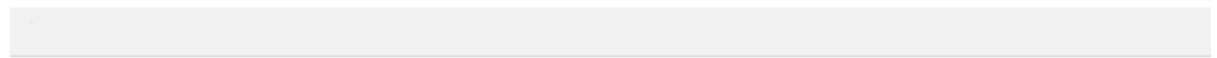

Installing and Licensing the Connect2018 UI

To install the Connect UI, go to the following link - [Connect 2018 Setup](#).

The Connect 2018 icon should appear on the Desktop.

If it does not appear, you may navigate to; C:\Program Files (x86)\KEY2ACT\Connect2018 and run the Connect.exe file.

Enter your user name and temporary password.
Click on *Log In*.

A pop up may appear asking to download updates. When this occurs, follow the instructions.

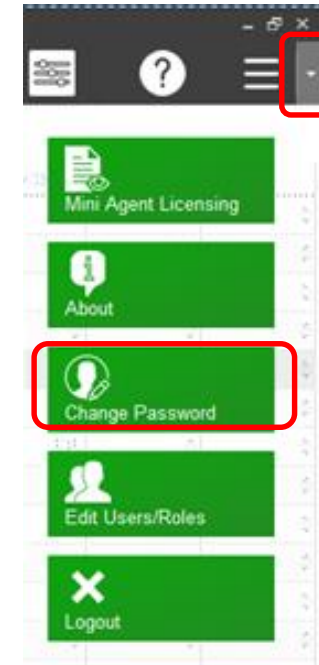

In rare cases where the site will be connected using BACnet over Ethernet then an additional piece of software must be downloaded and installed.

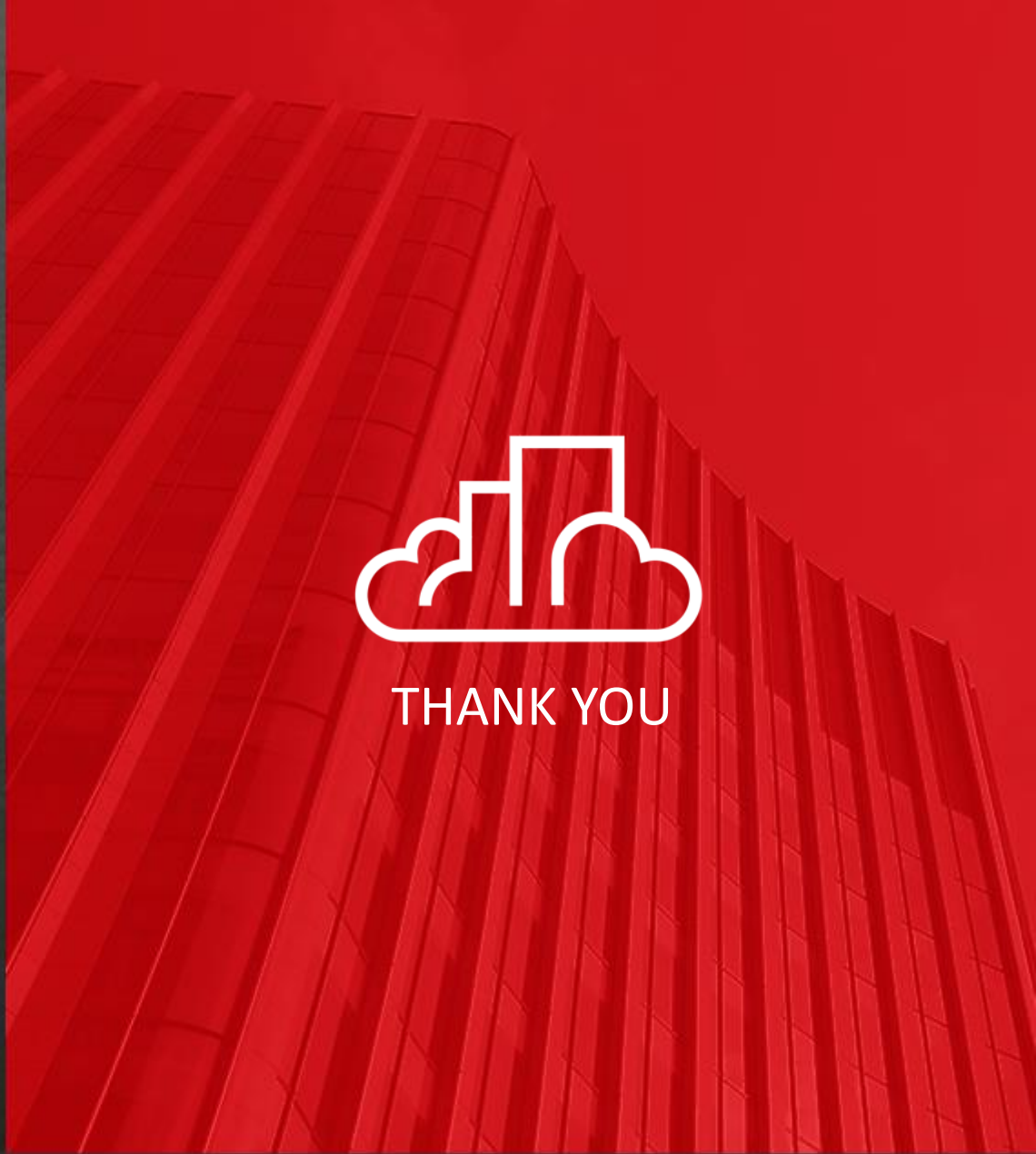


Windows Packet Capture
